



## Display Competition

### Requirements:

Each school may submit one display.

The displays from two schools will be set up on a six foot long table. The display for each school may take up no more than half of the table in length. The table is approximately 29 inches deep. The display must be free standing.

Displays must be set up when the school registers for the conference either Friday night or Saturday morning.

Each school may submit one display only, at the time of registration as noted above.

The judges will evaluate the displays based on the following criteria:

- Originality (is it unique)
- Creativity (used imagination)
- Theme (representation of the Theme *AppleLand: Getting to the CORE of community*)
- Representation (of the school or residence life program)

Each of the criteria will be weighted equally in determining the display competition winner.

Should a tie exist on overall score, the scores of individual criteria will be used in the order listed above, to determine the winner.

Displays may be picked up from the closing banquet.
