



Overall Spirit Competition

The great thing about the spirit competition is that EVERY SCHOOL is a part of it. There is no special registration to be a part of the competition. Not only is every school a part of the competition, but every school will help choose the winning schools.

At registration the advisor will receive one ballot that displays the names of all the delegations in attendance at the conference. The ballot will be divided into two lists- one for small residential programs and one for large residential programs. The size determining whether a school has a large or small program will be made based on which schools register for the conference.

After the last program session, at the beginning of the swap shop, all schools should gather to decide which school from each category they believe has had the most spirit throughout the conference. This spirit decision should be based on a combination of all aspects of involvement and attitude at the conference and the RA delegates from each school should do their best to work together to select which school they think had the best overall spirit at the conference. These forms should be given to a Shenandoah representative at the swap shop NO LATER than 5 pm.
