



Roll Call Competition

This competition allows each school's delegation to show off their school spirit, staff, and department while greeting each other uniquely. Each school will have the chance to present their own roll call in any way they choose - from music, cheers, skits, dances, or by even combining options. It will be a celebration of spirit, school pride, and the experience that is residence life, while demonstrating those unique qualities and characteristics of Virginia colleges and universities.

Each school will have a **maximum of 4 minutes**, which includes entering and exiting the stage. In order to accommodate the large amount of delegates and schools present, please stick to the time allotted. Should the school exceed the 4 minute time limit, they will not be eligible to receive an award for roll call. Our goal is to give schools the opportunity to showcase their students and school, while allowing everybody to become more relaxed and excited about the rest of the day at the conference.

Each school participating in roll call must indicate their participation at the registration table on Friday evening or Saturday morning. Additionally, at the time of registration, if a CD is being used, it must be turned in and labeled with your school's information as well as the track number for the song to be played.

The event will be judged by three main qualifications:

- Creativity (15%)
- School Spirit (20%)
- Incorporation of Conference Theme (15%)

The top three scores will receive prizes during the evening banquet. We will be randomly selecting schools during registration for the order in which they will go. As roll call begins, we will announce the entire lineup for schools. During the roll call event, there will be one team performing, another on deck, and a third school in the hole. Other than these three schools, it is expected that the rest of the delegation is present to cheer for and support the presenting school.

It is not necessary to incorporate your entire staff attending into the roll call, but you are more than welcome to if you would like. Have fun with this and get ready to celebrate each other's uniqueness and creativity. Please note that no food or beverages are allowed in the auditorium. No glitter, confetti or streamers are allowed in the auditorium or on stage.
